

Pā'ani House Rules

Please follow our simple house rules as they are part of your rental agreement and will make your stay as our guests, more enjoyable for everyone.

- Keep lock box key in lock box 4 emergencies. Key inside for daily use.
- Leave dirty or sandy shoes outside. Hose sand off feet before coming in. There is a hose on the back lanai & a foot bath at the front door.
- No animals or smoking are allowed in the house. Please do not leave butts in the yard. An ashtray for outside use is under the kitchen sink. Empty ashtray into dumpster in the parking area, not into house trash.
- Be respectful of the neighbors (noise and privacy.) 10 PM is quiet time.
- Please, don't sit / lie on the upholstered furniture or beds with bathing suites on after being in the ocean. The salt goes into the fabric & ruins it quickly. Remind & watch the children for this & the sandy feet thing.
- Read The Puamana House Rules in this book. Your pink parking tag is on the kitchen bar. Keep it visible in the car. Call Suzanne, 828-1918 if you have a problem with anything in the unit. Susan Gilmore, Puamana's manager, is a sweet heart but a stickler for the rules. Park only in slots labeled Resident 14, golf course side of lot, closest to Pā'ani. Read 3Ws.

Upon check out: Check out at 10AM

- Leave no dirty dishes or food in rooms or sink, including Tupperware.
- Take out the trash to the dumpster.
- Return everything where you found it including dishes, utensils, furniture and beach toys.
- Bring the pink parking ticket back in from the car & leave on the bar.
- Put front door key with golf ball & the pool key on the bar
- Turn off lights, fans, and any small appliances.
- Make sure lock box key is in the lock box.
- Close windows & lock the doors.

You will be charged extra for things that need to be put right if these rules are not followed (but we know you will!)
